Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarship

At ICMS there is an integrated college community of international and Australian students, embracing all cultures and the benefits of such diversity. It is a key value of ICMS to enable students from all backgrounds to have an opportunity to study at tertiary level. ICMS can provide scholarships for both tuition and/or accommodation, to help Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples.

These Scholarships provide tuition fee waivers to a level decided by the ICMS Scholarship Board. The ICMS Scholarship Board is also able to consider Accommodation/Living Costs scholarships for the eligible applicants.

The ICMS Scholarship Board will manage the selection and allocation of funds.

Value: UP TO \$40,000*

Applications Due: 5pm on Friday 10 January 2025 (for the February 2025 study period)

How to Apply:

- 1. Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria found below
- **2.** Complete your application and prepare your report supporting your application and other documentation if required
- Apply online at www.icms.edu.au/scholarships by Friday 10 January 2025**.

Eligibility:

The eligibility requirements for the ICMS Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarships are as follows:

- 1. Can demonstrate being an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person
- 2. Must have successfully completed Year 12 (HSC Record of Achievement or equivalent***).
- 3. Applicants under any of the above categories must prepare a one-page report in support of their application (refer to Report for details).

Meeting the scholarship eligibility criteria doesn't guarantee that you'll be awarded a scholarship. The ICMS Scholarship Board will reserve the right to decide to award these Scholarships.

Value of the Scholarship is indicative only and varies according to the course undertaken and may vary from the estimated UP TO value printed here, and from year to year.

Report:

Please submit a one page report addressing the following points:

- Why do you believe you should be awarded this scholarship?
- Why ICMS?
- Why is your chosen course the best choice for you?
- Any other information you wish to include to support your application

Selection Process:

- ICMS Scholarship Board will award these scholarships after considering the information contained in the applications submitted.
- The application form (and allowed supplementary information) is designed to gather sufficient information from applicants to determine which applicants best meet the eligibility criteria.
- Scholarships applications will be assessed based on the information provided in the application and the supporting documentation.
- Students who meet the eligibility criteria will progress to the interview stage. The interview is conducted by the ICMS Scholarship Board.
- The decision of the ICMS Scholarship Board is final.

Offer Material:

If your application and interview for this Scholarship is successful, you'll receive a scholarship offer with your letter of offer for a place in your course.

Your offer material will include details about the scholarship you've been awarded and terms and conditions for accepting the offer.

When you accept a Scholarship offer, you must agree to provide any personal information requested to assess your ongoing eligibility for the Scholarship.

Your Scholarship offer is made on the condition that you remain eligible to receive the Scholarship on each census date during the currency of your Scholarship.

Deferment:

Deferment of this Scholarship is not permitted prior to your course or during.

Students awarded this Scholarship who defer the start of their studies or who withdraw from their course, will forfeit their Scholarship. Students may re-apply for a scholarship if they start studies at ICMS at a later date.

Termination of this Scholarship:

If the Scholarship you've been awarded is for longer than one year, it will be terminated if:

• The maximum duration of the Scholarship has been reached (if applicable)



- You've failed to make satisfactory academic progress as defined by ICMS
- You've committed misconduct (e.g. provided false or misleading information See Student Handbook)

NOTE: Scholarship submissions will not be returned. Unsuccessful applications are not retained and will be securely destroyed.



Terms & Conditions (please read carefully before signing the declaration)

- 1. The Scholarship recipient is required to sign this acceptance form and return to the ICMS Scholarship Board on or before enrolment.
- 2. International College of Management, Sydney (ICMS) Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarship is not refundable and non-transferrable, meaning the scholarship cannot be converted to another program, education provider, or recipient nominated by the original recipient.
- 3. The recipient of the ICMS Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarship agrees to abide by all admissions criteria and rules and regulations prescribed by the ICMS whilst enrolled.
- 4. The recipient acknowledges and upholds the confidentiality of receiving the ICMS Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarship.
- 5. The recipient of the ICMS Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarship must commence the program in the study period commencing February 2025.
- 6. Once the successful recipient has been notified of the scholarship value, that value is not negotiable and not changeable.
- 7. Partial scholarships are likely to be awarded when application numbers are high.
- 8. The ICMS Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarship is not available to students using any other scholarship, bursary or discount at ICMS.
- 9. The ICMS Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarship offers a tuition wavier and/or accommodation/living costs credit.

Accommodation/Living Costs Credit description:

Rooms are equipped with a desk, wardrobe, heating and wireless internet. All linen is provided and rooms are dusted and vacuumed once a week. Each floor is equipped with a kitchenette, common showers, toilets and ironing facilities. You will also receive residential support from the residential assistants.

Your accommodation/Living Costs credit includes the following for the duration of the scholarship credit and eligibility:

- Rent
- 3 x Meals per day (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner) Monday to Friday
- 2 x Meals per day (Brunch and Dinner) Weekends
- Electricity, Gas & Water
- On site parking
- Campus wide Wi-Fi
- 10. If the recipient of an ICMS Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarship fails a subject, he / she may be obliged to retake the subject at their cost; this decision will be at the discretion of the Chair of ICMS Scholarships.
- 11. ICMS provides support and assistance, through the Academic Learning Department and Wellness Department here at the college. It is expected that the student where required or needed will be proactive in seeking these services as required in order to complete their studies to the best of their ability.
- 12. The ICMS Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarship offers a tuition waiver and/or accommodation that can only be used for the purpose and duration of attending ICMS for the program as specified. The balance of additional fees, including any uniforms, books and any other program related costs for each enrolling study period must be paid in full prior to study period commencement.
- 13. The ICMS Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarship is not able to be deferred.
- 14. The ICMS Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarship recipients must be 18 years of age within six months of commencing the ICMS Degree.
- 15. ICMS Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples Scholarships may be discontinued by the College, dependent upon termly



- review of academic standing, professional conduct, appropriate conduct and College and Community Contribution hours (if applicable).
- 16. Academic Integrity: Academic misconduct will be reviewed from time to time. Any academic misconduct can inhibit your scholarship. Should your academic misconduct be registered as level 2 or 3 during your applicable scholarship, the scholarship credit will be immediately discontinued.
- 17. College fees are subject to change.
